2010 Official Rules and Regulations

These official rules govern the conduct of the raffle. By making a donation to the Rotary Club of Goleta Noontime Foundation, you will receive raffle ticket(s), you agree to be bound by these official rules and the decisions of the Rotary Club of Goleta Noontime Foundation ("RCGNF"), which shall be final. State of California Non-Profit Raffle Registration #R-02251.

ENTRY: You must be 18 years of age to participate. Winner need not be present to win. A ticket donation/purchase reflects your agreement to abide by all terms of the raffle, and all city, county, state and federal laws and regulations. Raffle participants and prize winners agree that RCGNF will be able to use their name and/or likenesses for media including television, radio, web and print. The list-of-prizewinners will be published on RCGNF's website. No one may share a ticket. RCGNF shall report payment to, and withhold applicable withholding amounts from, the ticket-holder(s) of record in accordance with applicable law. All tickets purchased prior to the Great Goleta Ball Drop cutoff time will have a numbered golf ball which corresponds to the ticket number. After the ball drop ALL raffle tickets pre-sold and sold during the Festival will be entered into the Raffle.

TICKET ORDERS: Tickets are \$5.00 each. You may buy as many tickets as you wish, subject to availability. To order tickets: send your request by mail to RCGNF, PO Box 164, Goleta, CA, 93116. RCGNF will reject any raffle ticket order if the check is not honored or returned for insufficient funds. The ticket receipt(s) will be mailed to first named ticket-holder. Tickets may not be changed, sold or transferred by the purchasing party or anyone else without the express written approval of RCGNF in its sole discretion.

REFUNDS: All raffle ticket sales are final. No other refunds are available. RCGNF assumes no responsibility for lost, late, misdirected or non-delivered mail, or any other failure to receive orders or deliver receipts prior to the drawing deadlines. A raffle participant's sole and exclusive remedy for RCGNF's breach shall be limited to the return of the purchase price paid for his or her raffle ticket(s). In no event shall RCGNF, its directors, officers, employees, agents or representatives be liable to any party for any loss or injuries to earnings, profits or goodwill, or for any incidental, special, punitive or consequential damages of any person or entity whether arising in contract, tort or otherwise, even if advised of the possibility of such damages.

PRIZES: All winners will be called by name during the raffle drawing and ball drop contest. A prize awarded to a winning ticket shall be shared equally among the named ticket- holder(s). Prizes are subject to tax withholding in accordance with applicable law. If any winner cannot be located after reasonable attempts to do so by RCGNF, or if any winner is deemed to be ineligible or does not otherwise claim his or her prize by 5:00 p.m. on the day that is 180 calendar days following the drawing, such winner will be deemed to have forfeited his or her prize. A list of winners will be posted on the maybe obtained by writing to RCGNF. Requests must be received in the 30 day period following the drawing. RCGNF, its directors, officers, employees, agents and representatives are not responsible for any injuries, losses or damages of any kind arising in connection with or as a result of a winner's acceptance or use of any prize. Each prize winner agrees to indemnify, defend and hold RCGNF, its directors, officers, employees, agents and representatives harmless from any and all losses, damages, rights, claims and actions of any kind arising in connection with or as a result of such winner's acceptance or use of any prize.

GRAND PRIZE AND OTHER PRIZE DRAWINGS: To be eligible, tickets must be purchased by the drawing time [scheduled during the July 4th Festival held at Girsh Park]. Winning tickets will be drawn at random from a drum containing all eligible raffle tickets. All drawing dates and locations, including without limitation, the drawing dates and locations for the grand prize and final drawing, are estimated dates and anticipated locations and are subject to change at the discretion of RCGNF. RCGNF reserves the right to conduct the prize drawings on alternate dates or at alternate locations. You need not be present to win.

GOLF BALL DROP RULES: On Sunday, July 4, 2010 [or rain date], at approximately 6:00 pm, the golf balls will be placed randomly in a bucket and lifted by a crane (provided by Specialty Crane & Trucking). They will be dropped toward the temporary make-shift hole on the grass at Girsh Park. The raffle ticket holder whose golf ball drops into the make-shift hole, will win the Grand Prize. If more than one golf ball goes into the hole, those golf balls will be placed in a container and one golf ball will be randomly drawn for the Golf Ball Drop Grand Prize. If no golf ball goes into the hole, then the ball landing closest to the hole will receive the Grand Prize. The ball closest to the hole will be determined by measuring the distance from the center of the hole straight to the ball by a pre-selected team of Judge(s). The winner's name will be announced at the Goleta Fireworks Festival and will be posted on our website at www.goletafireworks.org. Anything herein to the contrary, notwithstanding, if some unforeseen event occurs that prevents the crane or the Rotary Clubs of Goleta from being able to conduct the Great Goleta Ball Drop and/or the Goleta Fireworks Festival Raffle, it will be re-scheduled to another time or all tickets will be processed and drawn to determine the Grand Prize winner.

The results by the Judges of the GREAT GOLETA BALL DROP will be final.

The raffle is void where prohibited by law.
